



Description of Courses of Studies of the Philosophy Department from 2013-2018

Courses of Studies 2012-13

Semester system was introduced in M.A. from July 2012.

Distribution of marks in each paper: 70 for the term end university exams and 30 marks for internal assessment

Changes in Courses

Earlier 8 papers were studied in two years. In Semester system the number of papers were increased into 16 with 4 papers being studied in each semester. Many new papers like 'Human Rights and Feminism', 'Applied Ethics', 'Western Analytic Philosophy', 'Social and Politics', 'Philosophy were added

Distribution of marks remained unchanged.

New revised courses of studies was introduced in M.A from Jan 2016.

Paper I was changed from 'Western Logic' to 'Symbolic Logic'. In Paper VIII 'Applied Ethics', new topics "Sexual harassment at work place" and "Moral Responsibility of which towards

Choice based credit system was introduced.

No change in distribution of marks

Paper XV was changed from 'Western Epistemology' to 'Western Epistemology and Philosophy of Science'. A new paper 'Scientific Method' was introduced.
