



Sir,

I am directed to inform you that the Post Graduate Research Council (Faculty of *Commerce*), Patna University at its meeting held on 19.01.2016 considered and resolved to approve the Ph.D registration of the candidates whose applications were recommended by the Departmental Council of the respective department after following the procedure laid down in Uniform Ordinance and Regulations governing award of Ph.D Degree by the Universities of Bihar approved vide letter no. BSU-05/2010-05/2010-1455/GS (I) dated 06.11 as per the details mentioned in the enclosed list with the following conditions:-

- a. The Registration/Admission is subject to the condition that the Reservation rules of the State Government on the vacant seats available has been followed by the Department concerned while recommending the proposals to the PGRC of the concerned Faculties.
- b. 



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

- n. Every candidate, on completion of the work and after the successful pre-Ph.D. presentation, shall submit along with his/her application of permission to present the thesis in the following manner:
 - i. Four type-written or computer printed copies of the thesis alongwith soft copy of the thesis.

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- ii A summary of the thesis not exceeding 200 words including in particular the nature of his/her own contribution to the advancement of knowledge in the subject.
 - iii A certificate from his/her supervisor that the candidate has worked satisfactorily for the requisite number of terms under his/her supervision and that the thesis embodies the candidate's own works
 - iv A certificate from the Head of Department that the candidate has worked in the Department for his/her research leading to Ph.D degree.
 - v The Supervisor has to give certificate of residence of the candidate in the 1st and the last term of research in the Department concerned and a certificate stating that the conduct of the candidate has been satisfactory during the period of his / her research.
 - o. The Research Scholar will have to deposit Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) only (\$ 1500 for NRI and Foreigners) as Examination Fee through Bank Draft drawn in favour of 'Controller of Examinations, Patna University', Patna at the time of the submission of thesis.
 - p. The Provisions of the Uniform Ordinance and Regulations governing award of Ph.D Degree by the Universities of Bihar communicated vide letter no. BSU-05/2010-1455/GS (I) dated 06.11.2012 of the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar will apply.
 - q. The letters to the applicants are being sent by post. The Department concerned will make a copy available to the candidate if he/she complains about the non-receipt of the copy.


