The University Department of Law, Patna University sought feedback responses from the parents/ guardians of the students enrolled in LL.M. programme up to 24.12.2018 on the basis of the prescribed Feedback Forms. A copy of such a Form filled by one of the parents/ guardians is attached herewith. The following is a brief report on the Feedback received:

**A. Description of the Analysis**

The Department received 17 (seventeen) filled up Parents Feedback Forms from the students of LL.M. (Sem I & Sem III). The overall analysis of the report shows a positive feedback on most of the criteria mentioned in the Feedback form on the point of regular classes, level of teaching, cooperation from the side of teachers, regular timely examination examination schedules, the parents are highly satisfied. None of the feedback forms show any instance of ragging being complained to the parents, On the point of other facilities in the department also the parents seemed satisfied and there is a positive response from the side of the parents on overall development of the student and the overall contribution of the university in the academic growth of the student.

**B. Description of the Shortcomings:**

On the basis of the analysis of the feedback, no shortcoming has been mentioned in the feedback forms duly filled by the parents. However, a critical analysis of all seventeen forms might suggest improvement in examination pattern and schedule and adoption of new methodologies of teaching and learning.

**C. Recommendations:**

The Department recommends the following on the basis of the above mentioned analysis of the feedback that more interactive classroom learning sessions should be encouraged with the aid of technology and practical learning approach.

**D. Action Taken/ Action to be Taken (if any) :**

The Department now has smart classroom with facilities of e-learning and teaching. Methods such as teaching through Powerpoint presentations, videos and web sources have been initiated. The Department has also taken steps towards more interactive learning by asking each student to participate as co-teacher in the classroom and learn from each other through interactive group presentations and viva.

The University Department of Law, Patna University sought feedback responses from the teachers of the department up to 24.12.2018. A copy of such Forms filled by the teachers is attached herewith. The following is a brief report on the Feedback received:

**A. Description of the Analysis**

The Department received 04 (four) Feedback Forms from the teachers of the University Department of Law. The overall analysis of the report shows a positive feedback on most of the criteria mentioned in the Feedback form on the point of suitability of syllabus to the course of LL.M., course content, academic resources, balance between theory and application, generation of interest, number of optional programmes and overall experience of the teachers. On the point of infrastructural facilities, the teachers gave a positive feedback except for the teacher's cabin and rooms. An analysis of the feedback form suggests that the administration is teacher friendly and the environment in the department is conducive to teaching and research. On the criterion of adopting new techniques of teaching all the four teachers strongly agree and they also agree to the proper coverage of all units in the syllabus including assignments and project works.

**B. Description of the Shortcomings:**

On the basis of the analysis of the feedback, some concerns were shown towards modification in course content and sufficient resource availability. The need was felt for proper Infrastructural facilities especially teacher's cabin and ladies toilet.

**C. Recommendations:**

The Department recommends that teachers should have a furnished cabin which would enable them to utilize their official presence in the department apart from classroom teaching. Modification in the syllabus of the course and exempting the repetitive course content from each paper was strongly recommended.

**D. Action Taken/ Action to be Taken (if any) :**

The Departmental Council has unanimously decided in the last meeting that furniture for the department will be purchased shortly.
